

  - → Move towards paperless environment




## **AER Commercial Department Considerations**

- Numerous contracts and agreements on hard copy file
- Many are outdated and need archiving
- Current agreements and commitments poorly understood
  - Has resulted in conflicts on the ground
  - Unprofessional
- Greater definition of responsibilities in the regions requires improved management and understanding of agreements
- Historical contracts and landholdings forgotten leading to repeat of past work






# **Commercial Inter-dependence**

## Why do we need a Commercial Database?

- Internal Control issues
- Confidentiality restrictions
- AOI limitations for Confidentiality Agreements
- Ignorance of existing conditions leads to conflicts of interest with business partners
- To improve transparency within AER, allowing relevant staff access to vital information



## Why do we need a Tenement Database?

- To enable high level overview of all existing land-holdings and improve new business strategies
- To review commitments on various leases
- To facilitate better planning and budgeting
- To monitor competitor information
- To keep track of historical tenement information (high staff turnover and growth)
- To integrate with all geotechnical data





## **Data Management**

- Online Register required for the following:
  - Commercial contracts
  - Tenement status
  - Mining legislation and commercial criteria (26 active countries)
  - Relevant RT authorities, directors, powers of attorney, bank mandates
  - New country Legal and Commercial due diligence



#### **Product Selection**

- South America Region developed own in-house system for contracts
  - Minimal support
  - Slow system
  - Numerous problems encountered in attempted adoption
- Range of software packages on Market
  - Generally all have limitations, either focussing on Contracts OR tenement
  - Some companies outsource tenement management
  - Limited GIS functionality
  - Other packages under review not fulfilling the entire needs of RTE

#### **Product Selection**

(...cont)

- Solution identified for AER = FlexiCadastre
  - Enterprise solution that adapts to existing platforms
    - will link into MapInfo, SAP, Documentum, GoogleEarth, etc.
  - Clients include Placer Dome/Barrick and various Ministries (DRC, Moz)
  - Backing of Global IS&T and AER Managers
  - Implementation in progress
- Advantages of FlexiCadastre
  - Does it all
  - Easy to use

#### Issues identified during implementation

- Review of internal work processes
- Requirement for standardisation of procedures and guidelines
- Many gaps identified within AER relating to internal compliance
- Importance of company secretarial documentation for local managers
- FlexiCadastre represents a powerful management tool with endless possibilities for Global adoption
