

## Successful Management of Resettlement Programs

Managing the **compensation** process for extensive mine site community relocation programs can include:

- Land
- Crops/Trees
- Buildings (Construction Agreements)
- Graves/Grave Sites
- Structures





## **Acacia Resettlement Process (1)**

- Resettlement Areas identified
- 2. Negotiate MOU with Villagers
- Survey Individual Land Parcels Land Owners and their Tenants (Survey Contractors)
- 4. Valuation of Property (Registered Valuers) Crops, Buildings, Graves etc.
- 5. Data Entry/Import into Landfolio



## **Managing Relocation of Graves**


- Specialised negotiators:
  - Single grave
  - Family graveyards
- Solutions:
  - Compensation Payment per grave according to a government rate
  - Move grave(s) to a new site (pay for exhumation, new coffin, new re-burial ceremony, funeral costs etc.)

- Highly Sensitive Issues:
  - Family graveyards
  - Inappropriate grave relocation sites
  - Religious issues







