






Workflow Design

Data and Documents

Phased Approach based on Priorities

- Focus on capturing critical current data first
- Then Post Go-live new data is added in Landfolio
- Review and Prioritize historical data capture
- Standardise file naming conventions

- Reporting outputs included in design






Training and Support
